## 1. - Introduction

The project, BOSS4SME, has been funded by the European Commission in the framework of the Erasmus Plus Programme – Action KA2 – Cooperation and Innovation for Good Practices.

The project consortium is composed of CENFIM (Spain), AMUEBLA (Spain), CCS (Greece), Eurocrea (Italy), AMIC (Spain), and Danmar (Poland).

BOSS4SME project will develop the European Furniture and household Sector through development of the **Online Sales Manager profile**, a professional capable of devising **e-Commerce** strategies for increasing revenues from cross-border sales through utilisation of the Internet as a sales channel.

In order to achieve its goals the project will develop a training path and related tools aiming to equip furniture and household professionals with the right skills to start selling online, especially cross-border and increase online sales revenues by addressing a much bigger audience.

This report forms part of the IO1 of the BOSS4SME project for the development of the Online Sales Manager Training Course (OSM). The report has been produced on the findings of the previous report developed during the BOSS4SME project:

### **O1 - A1 - E-commerce practices in furniture industry and GAP identification between partners' Countries and leading countries;**

The document provides information on the skills and knowledge, based on ESCO and O\*NET, needed to cover the identified GAPs. As result, 58 skills have been defined as necessary to cover the detected GAPs. Skills have been aligned with the related knowledge.

## 2. - Objective

The objective of this deliverable is to deliver a document which includes the **skills and knowledge needs identified for the Online Sales Manager profile of the furniture sector**, based on the GAPS defined in the previous activity (O1 / A1 - Rationalization Phase) and which are summarized in the following table:

### 3.- Methodology

**Skills, Competencies, Occupations, Knowledge and Qualifications** are today defined by different national or international **databases**, such as **ISCO, ISCED, DISCO, ESCO, DOT, O \* NET or SOC**, whose objective is to classify and standardize the different occupations existing in the labor market and relate them to their training needs and competencies. However, **the classification and standardization of occupations differs between such databases** because they are not classified in the same way in Europe as in the United States.

In addition, the academic literature on jobs and skills is extensive and covers many contributions on job creation, skills upgrading... among a wide range of different topics. Today, **the employment structure is constantly changing and new jobs**, such as **e-commerce in the furniture sector**, and **skills are emerging**, so literature and databases are constantly being updated.

Therefore, in order to achieve the objectives defined in this stage O1 / A2, **the data provided by two international databases, the European ESCO and the American O \* NET, have been analyzed and compared.**

The current version of both databases does not exactly include the occupation "**Online Sales Manager**" or "**e-commerce**", so that, in order to obtain the knowledge and skills of this occupation according to the GAPS, occupations directly related to electronic commerce and the sale of furniture have been identified in both databases, analyzing the different skills and knowledge associated with each one of them. The information extracted has been analyzed and compared, identifying **common knowledge and skills** as well as those that do not appear in both databases, but are detected as necessary to cover each GAP defined in O1 / A1.

The following figure represents a **summary of the methodology used to achieve the objectives of the O1 / A1 phase**. A first step to cover each GAP describes the knowledge that needs to be acquired by SMEs and especially their professionals. In a second step, the knowledge described is related to a specific skill needs. Thus, at the end of the report a table linking gaps, knowledge and skills will be developed.




Figure 1. Methodology to define skills needs in E-Commerce in the furniture sector

### **3.1- ESCO and O\*NET Databases**

Before starting to extract comparative data it is necessary to know the two databases to be used: **ESCO AND O\*NET**.

#### **WHAT IS ESCO?**

**ESCO:** is the multilingual **classification of European Skills, Competences, Qualifications and Occupations**. ESCO is an important deliverable to support the Europe 2020 strategy and the New Skills Agenda for Europe.

The Commission services launched the project in 2010 with an open stakeholder consultation. DG Employment, Social Affairs and Inclusion manages the development and continuous updating of the ESCO classification. In this work, it is supported by stakeholders and by the European Centre for the Development of Vocational Training Cedefop.

The **ESCO classification identifies and categorises skills, competences, qualifications and occupations relevant for the EU labour market and education and training**. It systematically shows the relationships between the different concepts. ESCO has been developed in an open IT format, is available for use free of charge by everyone and can be accessed via the ESCO service platform.

A demo version of ESCO (ESCO v0) was published on 23 October 2013. This release marks the beginning of the pilot and testing phase. **The first full version of ESCO (ESCO v1) is expected to be released mid-2017.**

## WHAT IS O\*NET?


**O\*NET**: The O\*NET Program is the nation's primary source of occupational information.

Valid data are essential to understanding the rapidly changing nature of work and how it impacts the workforce and U.S. economy. From this information, applications are developed to facilitate the development and maintenance of a skilled workforce.

Central to the project is the O\*NET database, containing hundreds of standardized and occupation-specific descriptors on almost 1,000 occupations covering the entire U.S. economy. The database, which is available to the public at no cost, is continually updated from input by a broad range of workers in each occupation.

O\*NET information is used by millions of individuals every year, including those taking advantage of O\*NET Online, My Next Move, and other publicly and privately developed applications. The data have proven vital in helping people find the training and jobs they need, and employers the skilled workers necessary to be competitive in the marketplace.

The Occupational Information Network (O\*NET) is developed under the sponsorship of the **U.S. Department of Labor/Employment and Training Administration** (USDOL/ETA) through a grant to the North Carolina Department of Commerce.

### 3.2- Knowledge related to E-commerce

As it was presented, the **O \* NET database** includes information on skills, knowledge, work activities and interests related to different occupations. Therefore, in order to determine the necessary knowledge required by an **E-commerce profile**, based on the GAPS defined in O1/A1, first it was selected from **O\*NET** database the occupations related to the **Online Sales Manager**.

The occupations in **O\*NET** are classified and standardized according to **O\*NET-SOC Code** ([https://www.bls.gov/soc/2018/soc\\_2018\\_definitions\\_without\\_changes\\_tracked.pdf](https://www.bls.gov/soc/2018/soc_2018_definitions_without_changes_tracked.pdf)), of which six have been identified as occupations related to the **Online sale of furniture**: **Online Merchants, Search Marketing Strategists, Sales Managers, Web Developers, Web Administrators and Graphic Designers**.

The following table shows the **O\*NET – SOC Code** and the description of each of the 6 occupations related to the **Online Sale Manager**:

The next step has been to **extract the knowledge of each of these occupations from the O \* NET database** and **compare them to each other**, extracting the common knowledge (Essential Knowledge) in at least two of the occupations to finally align them with the GAPS identified in A1 / O1.

**Annex I** contains the comparison of the knowledge of each one of the occupations related to the e-commerce in the furniture sector, extracting the **common ones of all of them**.

Table 5 shows the key of colour for common knowledge in more than one occupation. Thus, Communications and Media, English Language and Computers and Electronics are Knowledge common to the six occupations related to e-commerce in the furniture sector according to the O\*NET database.

**NOTE:** at the time of this analysis, ESCO Database did not collect the knowledge associated with each occupation, so it was not possible to compare the two databases.

### 3.3.- Skills needs

Once the necessary knowledge has been identified and as has been done in the previous section, the **occupations related to e-commerce in the furniture sector have been identified in the European ESCO database**.

In ESCO, each occupation is mapped to exactly one **ISCO-08 code**. ISCO-08 can therefore be used as a hierarchical structure for the occupations pillar. Since **ISCO** is a statistical classification, its occupation groups do not overlap. Each **ESCO occupation** is therefore mapped to only one **ISCO** unit group. It follows from this structure, that **ESCO** occupation concepts can be equal to or narrower than **ISCO**

unit groups, but not broader. The result is a strictly mono-hierarchical structure where each element at level 2 or lower has exactly one parent.

A few groups of ISCO-08 do not contain ESCO occupations. These are usually occupation groups with no economic activity in the EU

### Translations of ISCO

**ESCO does not adapt the ISCO occupation groups**, but the Commission manages translations of ISCO labels in the official languages of the European Union. For the various language variants ESCO uses the translations of the Commission Recommendation of 29 October 2009 on the use of the International Standard Classification of Occupations (2009/824/EC) if available.

Therefore, the occupations identified in the ESCO database related to electronic commerce in the furniture sector are:

Table 8 shows a list of the **108 skills that are common in at least two of the six occupations identified in ESCO**. According to the color key (Table 4), 89 skills are common in two occupations (yellow), 16 are common in three (orange) and **only 3 skills related with programming are common in four (green) of the six occupations**. It is striking that no appears common skills in all six occupations.

The same process has been done for the **O \* NET database, extracting skills** corresponding to the six chosen occupations. **Annex III** contains the identification of these skills and their relationship between them.

In this case, **44 skills are common in at least two of the six occupations**, with 10 common skills in all of them, 8 common in five occupations, 6 in four, two in three occupations and 18 skills common in two occupations.

The 10 common skills: **Data base user interface and query software, Electronic mail software, Graphics or photo imaging software, Office suite software, Reading Comprehension, Spreadsheet software, Video creation and editing software, Web page creation and editing software, Web platform development software and Writing**, are going to be considered essential skills for the formation of the Online Sales Manager profile in the furniture sector (Table 9 and colour key in table 4).

After analyzing and extracting the common skills in each database, it has been **compared the 108 skills extracted from ESCO with the 44 extracted from O \* NET in order to extract common skills again between the two databases and finally align them with the identified GAPS.** The common skills between both databases are considered **ESSENTIAL SKILLS** for the training in Online Sales Manager profile of the furniture sector.

**Annexes IV and V** contain the comparative tables of common skills between ESCO and O \* NET.

Finally **Annex VI** collects **alignment GAPS with knowledges, common skills** between the two databases (essential skills) and those that are not common but are considered to be part of the formation profile in study (optional skills).

According to **Figure 8**, the **orange color** of the skills means that these come from the **ESCO database** while the **greens skills** come from **O \* NET**. The color of the common column is related to the number of common skills in different analyzed occupations in accordance to the colour key of table 4.

#### 4.-Conclusions

- The start point is **GAPs** identified in the previous activity: **product information build trust, facilities for product selection, website usability, marketing tools and internationalization.**
- The identified GAPs have been related with **7 knowledge categories**: **sales and marketing, communication and media, design, customer and personal service, search tools, usability, and English language.**
- **Sales manager, Web Developer, Web Manager, Retailer Online (or Online Merchants), Search Marketing Strategists (or Managing website) and Graphic Designer** are the six occupations identified in **ESCO** and **O \* NET** as the closest to the profile of Online Sales Manager in the furniture Sector. The analysis and comparison of the skills of these selected occupations have resulted in the essential skills of the Online Sales Manager in the furniture Sector profile.
- **Client / server (programming), PHP programming and Web programming** are common skills in 4 occupations according to the **ESCO database**.
- **Data base user interface and query software, Electronic mail software, Graphics software or photo imaging software, Office suite software, Reading Comprehension, Spreadsheet software, Video creation and editing software, Web page creation and editing software,** are the 10 common skills in the 6 chosen occupations in the **O \* NET database**.
- **58 common skills** have resulted from comparing the occupations selected in both databases. **These skills have been aligned with GAPs and Knowledge previously identified.**


